From the Pastor's Desk



Baptists have always been people of the Book. We have always valued, treasured, and revered the Bible. It is "the true center of Christian union, and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and religious opinions should be tried." (Baptist Faith & Message)

Have you considered the descriptions of the Bible in the Old and New Testaments? The Bible says it is "The Book of the Law, the Good News, Holy Scripture, Law of the Lord, Living Words, Message of Christ, Scripture, Sword of the Spirit, Truth, Word of God, Word of Life, Word of the Lord." These words from the Book itself tell us why it's so important for us to know what the Bible says.

At Zion Hill Baptist we focus on making disciples by studying and encouraging others to be saved as the Bible says we must be saved: by faith in Jesus Christ, and living as the Bible says we must live, by faith, as we obey God's Word.

In June, that focus will be emphasized as we have Vacation Bible School Sunday, June 24, through Thursday, June 28, from 6:00-8:00. On Sunday mornings we have Bible Study at 9:45 and Worship at 10:55. On Sunday nights we have Discipleship and Growth Groups at 5:00 and Worship at 6:00. And, I want to remind you about Wednesday night. The *Switch* in the basement is a time of worship and Bible Study led by Bro. Matt and Daren Brenneise, reaching youth and young adults. In the auditorium there is Bible Study and Prayer Meeting for adults. And then the Mission Friends, Royal Ambassadors, and Girls in Action are for the children, and they meet in the Fellowship Hall. The adults in the auditorium with me are looking at the foundational doctrines of our church in the Baptist Faith and Message. Every time we meet here at Zion Hill Baptist Church, our focus is on the Bible. We seek to be like the early church of whom it is said, "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." (Acts 2:42)

Many things have changed about our world, technologically, socially, and economically, but our devotion to the Bible must never change. Let's get together and study God's word this month. I'll hope to see you here for Church and for VBS.
