From the Pastor's Desk

Psalm 100:4 has always been one of my favorite Bible

verses. It reminds me of the importance of Thanksgiving. I really do not care for the modern trend to skip over the holiday of Thanksgiving and go right to the consumer frenzy that is Christmas. I also do not care for the fact that so often people today give Thanksgiving only a brief oncea-year thought, when God deserves our Thanksgiving and praise every minute of every day of our lives. Think about Psalm 100:4 and what it says. "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be Thankful to Him, and bless His name."

When David wrote these words, he was thinking of the ancient Tabernacle, and the Temple that he hoped to build in Jerusalem. As God's people approached those ancient structures they were to do it with Thanksgiving. We should enter the church today with gratitude for all that God has given us and bless His name because of all that He has done for us. Yet, so many times we come with different attitudes, and little gratitude. We come with our minds not on what He has done, but on what we wish we were doing instead of "wasting our time" in church. We think about where we will eat, how crowded a restaurant will be, or how long the preacher will talk this morning. With our mind somewhere else and on other things, we will leave wondering why we didn't get anything out of the church service. It's all in the approach. Try coming with Thanksgiving and praise, and you will enter not just a church building, but the throne room of God in Heaven.

Can you offer Thanksgiving alone at home, or on a golf course, or on a deer stand, or on a lake waiting for a fish to take a nibble at your bait? Yes, you can!!

This verse does not rule out private, and personal, prayers of thanks-giving and praise, but it encourages us to also come together with God's people in public times of worship. It involves our uniting together as the people of God as we offer thanks to Him for the privilege of being able to be together in harmony, all saying "Thank you, God!" It teaches us that there is a special advantage in thanksgiving that involves the whole people of God together, and not just the private prayers of individuals.

What a wonderful thing to trust in Jesus, the fulfilment of all the sacrifices of the Old Testament, except for the sacrifice of thanksgiving. What a joy to know that because of Jesus not only are the church doors open, but the very holy of holies in Heaven itself is accessible to us when we enter with Thanksgiving!

They're not just kids; they're Hiz Kidz! Here at Zion Hill we are changing our kids ministry a bit. Rather than having ministry activities for the children only, we want to include the parents. Modern technology gives us the choice each day to let technology raise our kids, or to use it as a tool to help us network with other parents and professionals, and use God's Word to be the best parents God would have us be. With that in mind, we plan to partner with parents to lead children into a life-long relationship with God! Sunday and Wednesday alone are not enough to teach a child the importance of a healthy relationship with Christ. We want to equip you to be able to lead your children in their walk with Christ at home as well.

Some of the things we plan to have to help parents include being able to help children with their school work, recognizing depression in your child, learning how to keep track of what your child can see online, and so on. These things are not necessarily biblical, but they help us understand our children, and enable us to work beside them more in life. We will have training sessions where we will teach parents how to do Bible storying with their kids, how to pray with their kids, and how to be parents that can train their children up to have a healthy fear for the Lord.

With the change in our children's ministry comes a new logo to kick things off. "Hiz Kidz" has been chosen for a reason. Obviously the "Z" goes along with us being "Zion Hill." The most important part of the name is that it reminds us that these children have been given to us as parents, and as a church, to raise in a way to glorify God. In other words, our kids are Hiz Kidz, with whom He has gifted us and given us the responsibility to raise and nurture in this life.

With a new theme, you will also begin to see this logo throughout our kids ministry areas.
