### From the Pastor's Desk

I recently came across a little advice on "How to Make or Break a Habit." I found myself inspired and I wrote down the four simple steps which were suggested.

Step #1—Do it Now! Any change delayed will be less likely to ever happen. Procrastination is the worst enemy of change.

Step #2—Do it openly. Call friends, and family; tell others what you plan to do, or stop doing. Let them celebrate the decision with you, pray for you, and hold you accountable.

Step #3—Repeat and recommit to the change often. Old habits die hard; you can expect to have relapses. It has been suggested that it takes six weeks to make new behavior permanent. Until then you have to keep thinking about it and remembering the decision you made. Temptation to fall back into the old pattern will be persistent.

Step #4—Ask God for help. This really should, I think, be the first step. God wants to help us stop the destructive habits in our life. He reveals His perfect will to us and only with His help, power, and mercy can we do the right things, and forsake the wrong things in our lives. The truth is it all starts with repentance, and confession. It is completed when He gives us His deliverance!

If you want to see your life change for good, and for forever, trust in God and let Him work in your life. So, give your heart to Jesus, renounce your sins, and leave them, and walk in the Spirit as a child of God!

### Message from Matt

Waiting.....been learning a good deal about waiting these days. Waiting on Natalie's finger to heal, waiting on my father's heart surgery, waiting to figure out what is wrong with my truck, and waiting to find out information that I need in order to plan some future events. I'll be honest, I HATE waiting.

We live in a society where we want answers, and we want them now, and I fit in with that mentality. When I was young, my mother always told me, "good things come to those who wait!" It still didn't make me want to wait. The things I am often most impatient about, however, are the answers and guidance of God. So many times I get in such a hurry to get things done and to find answers to problems around me that, in my impatience, I begin to work on solutions and fixes to the problems when I don't feel God answers things in the time I am happy with. As we have waited on news from 4 different doctors on Natalie's broken finger, I have realized that I can't get in a hurry. I don't have the training and knowledge to diagnose and make a plan for proper healing. With my dad's surgery, I have to patiently wait on the surgeon to do his job. I can't help him in an effort to speed him up. I am not qualified to help with such an obstacle. Waiting to find out what is causing problems with my truck is not fun. To be honest, it is frustrating! However, once again, I must wait because I am not qualified and experienced to find and/or fix the problem. I find myself in a hurry to get answers that are needed in order to get future events scheduled so I can be better prepared. However, I am not in the position to make some of the decisions for which I need answers.

So as I wait...and wait...and wait, I find God asking me one simple question; "If you can understand why it is so important to be patient and wait for the best answers from the best people in your life in certain situations, then why can't you understand and trust to be patient with me, the all-knowing, all-powerful, God of your salvation?" The only response I know to make is, "I am sorry, God." May we all learn to be patient and trust God in all that He is working out in our lives.
