From the Pastor's Desk



The Bible Study I'm doing had this question a few days ago. "What are the most important things to know about being a Christian?" This list is my answer.

First, know that you are very special. God created you uniquely, with your own gifts and talents. See how great a love I have for you that you should be called my child, for this is what you are (I John 3:1). I formed your inward parts. I knit you together in your mother's womb (Psalm 139:13). I know the number of hairs on your head (Matthew 10:30). You are fearfully and wonderfully made (Psalm 139:14). You are precious in my sight, and I love you. (Isaiah 43:4)

Second, pray. Because He loves you, He wants to give you all the best. Call upon me, come and pray to me and I will listen to you (Jeremiah 29:12). Ask and it shall be given to you; seek and you shall find; knock and it shall be opened to you (Matthew 7:7). I know all that you need. Just seek me first, and all these things will be given to you (Matthew 6:32–33).

Third, do not be afraid. There will be times in your life when you start to worry or feel anxious about something. But I tell you, do not be anxious for anything, but in everything, with prayer and thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to Me (Philippians 4:7). Trust in Me with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding (Proverbs 3:5). I cause all things to work together for good to those who love Me, and who follow my path (Romans 8:28).

Fourth, forgive others, and forgive yourself. People will do you wrong. You will make mistakes sometimes. God knows, *All have sinned and fallen short of My glory* (Romans 3:23). *But if you confess your sins, I will forgive you.* (I John 1:9). *As far as the east is from the west, so will I remove your sins from you* (Psalm 103:12). *However, there is a requirement: If you forgive others, I will forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, I will not forgive you* (Matthew 6:14–15). When he forgives you, forgive yourself.

Five remember to always trust Christ. For the rest of your life, people will tempt you to put your hope and trust in things of this world. They will claim that money, possessions, status, and good looks will bring you happiness. But this isn't true. Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But lay up treasures in Heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy and where thieves do not break in or steal (Matthew 6:19–20). For what shall it profit you to gain the whole world, and forfeit your soul? (Mark 8:36) The same one who gave you the gift of eternal life by faith also wants to give you so much more. For I know the plans I have for you. Plans for good and not evil, to give you a future and a hope (Jeremiah 29:11). Don't let your heart be troubled or afraid (John 14:1). Be strong and courageous (Joshua 1:9). And remember, I am with you every step of the way (Matthew 28:20).

I hope to see you in September as we worship God together.

Special Studies starting September 9, 5-7pm

In September and October during Discipleship time we will host a special study for the ladies and the men. We will start promptly at 5:00pm each evening and go through 7:00pm. We will start each study off with a short time of food and fellowship and then quickly jump into our studies. Ladies' Study: Hebrews, by Lisa Harper

The Book of Hebrews is a rich, dense section of Scripture that can intimidate the most scholarly biblical student. But Lisa Harper makes digging into Hebrews fun and doable, as only she can, without losing an ounce of depth. Hebrews was a sermon for a specific people and culture in the midst of martyrdom and persecution, but is also so relevant for us today, reminding us to continue walking toward Jesus regardless of our culture or our circumstances. Join our ladies as they journey through this bridge between the Old and New Testaments to get to the heart of the matter: Jesus is our accessible King. He is not a faraway God, but an up-close Redeemer who draws near to us. Hebrews helps women make the connection between God the Father and God the Son and reminds us that Jesus is supreme, but He is also compassionate, empathetic, and loving to no end.

Men's Study: Act Like Men, by James MacDonald

In many ways, our culture paints an unsavory and unseemly picture of manhood. The standard for how a man acts and conducts himself continues to be lowered. While some might see men's roles as insignificant, God tells a different story. God says that men matter, and He's appointed them to lead. Men fulfilling this role is vital to the health of our homes, churches, and society. Unfortunately, too many men follow the way of the world, instead of embracing the call of God. Instead of stepping up to their responsibility, they are stepping back.

In this study, you will be challenged to take hold of your Godgiven role. Through video teaching, group discussion, and personal Bible study, you will be urged to live out Paul's instruction in 1 Corinthians 16:13-14.
