## From the Pastor's Desk

Gatekeeper or Gate greeter

Gates are mentioned often in the Bible, and the gatekeepers were very important and prestigious men.

The Ancient cities had thick walls around them to discourage invaders and heavy gates that controlled who entered or exited the city. The gatekeeper had to be trustworthy and ready to prevent anyone who might try to cause trouble. In Psalm 141:3 the Lord Himself is described as being the "guard of our mouths."

David and Samuel appointed 212 porters to keep the gates of the Temple of the Lord. Ezra records that 139 gatekeepers made the return trip to Jerusalem with Zerubbabel. And Nehemiah, after the wall around Jerusalem was rebuilt, appointed gatekeepers. Before the city could be considered back in business, it had to have guards for the gates.

Many today feel called to be gatekeepers, of sorts, in the church, maintaining traditions, keeping order, limiting change, and keeping outsiders away. I will admit that there is some value in that position even today. I understand where the gatekeepers are coming from.

I believe, however, that Christ has called us to a different position. It is our privilege to be gate greeters. We are to welcome people into a relationship with Christ, to include them in our Family, to invite them to share in the joy of worship. To encourage new people and introduce them to Jesus.

Jesus came not only to show us how to live by God's rules, but the purpose behind the rules. (Matthew 5:17) In Jesus we learn that God's love for us is so unfathomable that we can't even begin to know how deep it goes. And that God's love is for all people; Jews, Gentiles, male, female, slave, or free. Once we receive His love and understand His love, we are to show His love to everyone, to share it with all the world. We are to welcome and to invite everyone to enter that relationship.

We are the greeters, a priesthood, a chosen race, a holy nation, and God's own people "in order that we may proclaim the mighty acts of Him who called us out of darkness into His marvelous light." (1 Peter 2:9)

We are to be gate greeters, on a mission with Jesus to reach those who are outside, and bring them inside His Holy City. As Jesus said in His sermon in Nazareth, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." (Luke 4:18-19) Jesus did not come to guard the gate against those who were unworthy to enter, but to throw open the gate so that whoever wants to might come into the presence of God. That is why I was allowed to enter Gods' Holy Temple and why you were allowed to enter. Now that we know Him, we should see ourselves as greeters, not as guards. Greeters who welcome all those who hear the invitation to come to Jesus. All those who are weary and heavy laden who come to Him and find rest.
