From the Pastor's Desk

Psalm 100 is one of the most beautiful Psalms. With all my heart I believe that we are a people, a nation, and a church that has been truly blessed by God, and we have many things to be thankful for. Of all those who "give thanks to Him and praise his name," we should be at the top of the list. It is common to have a Christmas wish list, and a New Years Resolution list. But there is another list we often overlook, a Thanksgiving Day list of all for which we are thankful.

Roland Allen tells of a veteran missionary who came to him one day after he had delivered his message. The missionary introduced himself and said, "I was a medical missionary for many years in India. I served in a region where many people became blind. The blindness was progressive. People were born with healthy vision, but there was something in that area that caused people to lose their sight as they matured."

The missionary and his team developed a process which would stop the progressive blindness. So people came to the hospital where he worked, and with surgery and medication he was able to stop them from becoming blind and in some cases restore their lost vision. They would leave realizing that they would now be able to see for the rest of their lives.

He said that they never said "Thank you," because in their dialect there was no phrase for that idea. Instead, they spoke a word that meant "I will tell your name." Wherever they went they would tell the name of the American missionaries who had cured their blindness. They had received something wonderful, and they eagerly and widely proclaimed it.

That is exactly how Psalm 100 begins. "Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands." Do you realize that God has been good to you? Then you should not keep that a secret or silently hold it on the inside. From the depths of your soul you should shout your joy out loud to the Lord!!!! THANK GOD for Thanksgiving. "Enter His gates with Thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him and bless His name!"
