One of my favorite songs is Above All, which was

written by Paul Baloche and Lenny LeBlanc. The first time I heard the song, Michael W. Smith sang it in 2001. The chorus especially moves me to tears, even after years of hearing the lines.

Crucified laid behind a stone

You lived to die rejected and alone

Like a rose trampled on the ground

You took the fall and thought of me

Above all!

It is incredible to me that Christ, the King of Kings, Lord of Lords, sovereign creator of all the universe, the one who is above all, would love me, a rebellious sinner so much that he would suffer, and die on a cross for my sin. That he would want to become my comforter, best friend, and pay for my sin with his own blood. I believe that as he died, he felt rejected, and alone, along with the physical pain and torture of crucifixion.
