

#### From the Pastor's Desk



Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God. Psalm 42:11 I have been preaching for 43 years and 25 years and 6 months of that time has been at Zion Hill. You would think that after all that time I would have nothing more to say. That I would find nothing new in the Bible. Strangely enough, the opposite seems to be true. I suppose that shouldn't be surprising because God's Word is inexhaustible. I have enjoyed the constant exploration of the treasures in God's word and trying to explain its meaning in messages to God's people. Many more sermons could be preached and at times it seems that I have only scratched the surface. when there is so much more to discover.

As I was praying and reading the Bible today God used Psalm 42:11 to speak to me. I have many things on my mind right now. I am grieving over friends whose funerals I preached this month. I should praise Him because of His victory over the struggles I face. He is the savior of my soul. He is the sovereign all-powerful, all-knowing ruler of the universe.

I do not think I am alone in needing this reminder from God, so I share it with you. I truly feel that it is a truth that many people need right now. It seems that we are experiencing a pandemic of depression and despair. If nothing else, many people seem to be suffering from a lack of joy. If that doesn't reflect how you feel these days, praise the Lord. But if it does, then I want to remind you as I have been reminded today that God's Word tells us that we can have hope, joy, peace, strength, and victory when we put our trust in God who is our savior.
