From the Pastor's Desk

What was Jesus like? We have all seen artist ideas of Jesus. Growing up Baptist, I cannot remember the first picture of Jesus I saw. I am sure it was in the Nursery of Arnett Benson Baptist Church. In Lubbock Texas, where I grew up. I have a picture that is supposed to be of Jesus, on the wall in my office across from my desk as I type this article. The problem with most of the representations of Jesus in art and film, is that he really did not look that way at all. Nobody really knows what he looked like. But we do have a good idea from the Bible of what he was like.

The four gospel writers, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, paint a picture of Jesus as a revolutionary, counter-cultural, life-changing Savior. Does that sound like Jesus to you? Or is your version of him more...tame? With the rise of modern conveniences and comforts, we run the risk of domesticating Jesus so he can fit into our busy, disjointed, suburban lifestyle. But that is NOT the Jesus we meet in the Bible. In many ways, we have molded Jesus to fit our image, upholding the status quo and making sure we do not get too uncomfortable. To read the gospels and know the real Jesus will not only change our lives, it may change the world.

Jesus was not physically weak. He probably looked more like Schwarzenegger, than the skinny sissy with long hair in the portraits. He was after all a carpenter in the days before power tools. He did all the hard physical work by muscle power alone. Neither was he the meek, timid mousey wimp that he is shown to be in films. He had the spiritual strength

to stand up to Pilate, and Herod, each one a representative of Rome, the most powerful nation in the world at that time. He had the strength to resist the attacks, criticism, and endless questions that came from the religious rulers, and leaders of the Day. He never flinched or compromised, to appease the powers that were. He stayed faithful, and strong in His commitment to do what God had sent Him to do.

He was strong enough to call fishermen, a tax collector, and a terrorist, to a lifelong commitment and loyalty to Him, that eventually cost them their lives. They followed him for three years, saw Him killed, and resurrected to life after three days. He was physically able to drive out money changers and thieves from His Father's House. He also called children to His side and blessed them. He broke long standing traditions, and set high standards for Godly behavior.

The most powerful thing about Him is His love. Unconditional love. Love that overcomes every obstacle, and never stops loving. Love that ultimately caused Him to give His life for those He loved. Love that enabled Him to suffer the most painful execution ever created by man. Love so strong that as His death occurred, He prayed for forgiveness of those who were killing Him.

Have you ever seen my Jesus? I mean the real Jesus. If you have, then you have met someone who demands your soul, your life, your all.


Operation Christmas Child

Children learn from trained, local volunteers what it means to follow Jesus and share their faith with friends and family. Let's share Jesus with them!






SUNDAY NIGHT BIBLE STUDY


