

The Importance of Children's Ministry in Reaching our Community for Jesus

I am confident that a thriving children's ministry is a one of the quickest ways to grow a healthy church. It is our opportunity to sow into the next generation of spiritual leaders and bring a great future to Zion Hill Baptist Church. Creating a safe, exciting, and inviting space where kids can learn about Jesus should get us excited. Children are the greatest and most significant mission field in our community!

Parents will do what's best for their children. That means they'll choose a church with a great children's ministry — if our church doesn't have one, they'll go somewhere else. Put yourselves in the shoes of a new family visiting our church. If they bring their kids to the children's area to check-in and see one volunteer in a dingy room with decor and toys that haven't been updated in twenty years, do you think they'll want to leave their kids there? Do you think the kids will want to come back?

If kids have a great time in our children's ministry and are excited to come back, their parents will as well! Plus, if parents are excited about what's happening at our church, they're much more likely to invite their friends and neighbors to come.

As a bonus, families with kids participating in our children's ministry are also more likely to volunteer in our church. They see us investing in their children an want to help contribute

to the work the church is doing. This may mean they volunteer with our children's ministry or that they step up in another area that needs help. Either way, we're increasing the engagement of our people.


